1/1/26 Line 1462 First mtg Council on Housing Development (COHD).

3/1/26 Line 765 OPM to issue guidelines for annual housing reporting by municipalities.

7/1/26 Line 1020 OPM to issue GIS tools to determine developable and redevelopable land.

12/1/26 Line 944 OPM to issue housing targets for state and regional COGs.

6/1/27 Line 962 COGs to publish regional housing needs assessment with recommended affordable housing goal for each community.

6/1/28 Line 812 COGs to publish regional housing growth plan for Eastern Connecticut or communities adopt their own plan.

6/1/29 Line 817 COGs to publish regional housing growth plan for Western Connecticut or communities adopt their own plan.

- f) All at the meeting confirmed their intention to stay on the committee into 2026. A former member of the committee has expressed interest in being on the committee.

We should check with P&Z first to make sure we are not stepping on their agenda at all especially regarding the Bailey Avenue Condo project which has a lawsuit.
