1. CALL TO ORDER

Chair Hendrick called meeting to order at 7:02 p.m. and quorum was established.

2. OLD/CONTINUED BUSINESS

2.1. (Continued) A-22-5: Regulation Text Amendment (per PZR 9.2.B) for Section 2.2; Section 4.6 and Section 8.8 for Inclusionary Zoning. *Commission initiated*. https://ridgefieldct.viewpointcloud.com/records/89747

Attorney Tom Beecher has not commented as of now. Continued to next regular meeting. *No objection*.

2.2. Discussion re: Digital Signage potential regulation change. <u>https://ridgefieldct.viewpointcloud.com/records/91467</u>

Purpose of this is to clarify parts of the current regulation. Chair Hendrick read parts of the regulation that would be clarified. The kelvin scale was discussed. Mr. Katz has suggested just not to allow lighted signs at all to avoid confusion. There was discussion on allowing digital/electronic signage in certain zones. Driver distraction was discussed. Limited hours of operation for digital signage was also discussed. It was also suggested to allow digital signs on a case-by-case basis by Special Permit. Chair Hendrick requested Alice Dew to upload the Power Point presentation that was presented to the online file. *Continued to next regular meeting.*

2.3. Charter Review Commission-Re: Ridgefield Affordable Housing Committee

Chair Hendrick stated the Charter Review Commission will not change Affordable Housing Committee and will keep it as is for now.

2.4. (Continued) Discussion and possible action re: bills under consideration at 2023 General Assembly legislative session.

The discussion on Saturday, April 29th was cancelled due to a funeral. Chair Hendrick will keep Planning and Zoning Commission updated.

3. NEW BUSINESS

3.1. A-23-1: Regulation Text Amendment (per PZR 9.2.B) for Section 2.2; Section 7.3.D for Electric Vehicle Charging Stations. *Commission initiated*. *For receipt and scheduling a Public Hearing*. https://ridgefieldct.viewpointcloud.com/records/91638

State statute is specific to any parking lot that has 30 or more spots. J. Soreno made motion to approve current draft as is and go to public hearing. Motion not seconded.
Motion to modify current language to make 30 parking spaces to 5 and to strike out words "and considering factors such as location, expected demographics, etc.' and move to a public hearing. (Maker: E. DiSalvo, second by J. Sorena) Unanimously passed.
Public Hearing scheduled for June 6.
Previous Motion on April 18 to open Public Hearing on May 16

3.2. Discussion on Outdoor Eating Areas

Public Act 22-1, enacted last year, is now in state statutes, permitting outdoor eating. As of May 1, towns are required to allow outdoor seating. There are some limitations/requirements. Due to legislature, Ridgefield has to update Regulations. Keep on Agenda for next meeting after commissioners have had chance to review. *Continued to next meeting*.
