#### Connecticut State Building Code section - 105.3 By Whom application is made.

#### Connecticut State Building Code section - 105.5 Expiration of Permit

Every permit issued shall become invalid unless the work on the site authorized by such permit is commenced within 180 days after its issuance, or if the work authorized by such permit is suspended or abandoned for a period of 180 days after the time the work is commenced. The building official is authorized to grant, in writing, one or more extensions of time, for periods of not more than 180 days each. The extensions shall be requested in writing and justifiable cause demonstrated.
